1. Service: The mare _____ Breed _____ Reg No _____
Breed _____ Reg No _____

will be bred to the stallion Splashdance for the 2010 fee of **\$850**. A non-refundable booking/handling fee of **\$350** is to be paid in advance of service and will be deducted from the service fee (GST not applicable).

All mares must arrive unshod and in good health.

2. Accounts: An Account listing all charges including the remainder of the service fee will be payable within seven days of positive pregnancy test or upon removal of the mare from Chalani, whichever comes first. It is expected that the mare will be removed within seven days of notification of positive pregnancy test.

3. Agistment: Agistment is \$8 per day, payable two weeks in advance. This includes daily hay. If you wish to supply your own hay, agistment will be \$6 per day, payable two weeks in advance. If supplied hay runs out and more is not supplied, agistment will be charged at \$8 per day. Other feed (supplied by owner) can be fed to the mare at a fee of \$1 per day. Any other special requirements charged at \$1 per day (ie rugging, separate paddock/yard/foal at foot) Agistment fees after Christmas increase by \$2 per day.

4. Veterinary Attention: It is recommended that a vet certification of freedom from infection is obtained prior to being served, at the mare owner's expense. A veterinary examination in the mare's cycle 3 weeks prior to the intended service cycle is recommended to check breeding soundness and conduct a health check (especially if a maiden or mare has had lots of foals. Checks on uterus and ovaries, scar tissue, possible infection, caslicks so that any issues can be rectified). Inoculations, particularly tetanus and strangles to be up to date. Vet fees with regard to the wellbeing of the mare, pregnancy testing, or to encourage a difficult breeder to conceive, will be billed directly to the mare owner. All mares to be wormed within a week prior to arrival.

5. Return Rights: Should the mare slip or fail to produce a live foal, Chalani must be notified within 48 hours of foaling. Chalani will accept the mare for **free** return service during the consecutive season only, upon payment of \$350 booking fee and usual veterinary charges and agistment, to the same stallion, (or substitute stallion if the above horse is no longer available.). If a mare is neglected or undergoes any veterinary interference which terminates the pregnancy (twinning excepted), or the mare is not returned, this contract becomes null and void. If the stallion dies and no substitute stallion is standing at stud at Chalani, this contract becomes null and void. *No refunds will be given.* Re-breeding in the same stud season does not require additional deposits/booking fees.

6. Approval of mares: Preference will be given to mares arriving in early spring. It is recommended they arrive 'in season' and are removed following ultrasound confirmation of pregnancy 20 days after mating. Mares will be accepted after Christmas and before September *only in unusual circumstances*. Preference will be given to registered A.S.H. mares, or mares of proven performance or temperament. If a mare is considered to be an unlikely breeder another approved mare may be substituted. All mares may be run with the stallion, however hand service is usual. If in the opinion of Chalani a mare is of doubtful temperament or breeding type, Chalani will request her removal and all fees and accounts will become due and payable.

7. Sale of in-foal mare: If at the time of the sale the mare is no longer pregnant, or in good health, this contract becomes null and void. A veterinary certificate of pregnancy at the time of sale is recommended.

8. Liability: Whilst every care will be taken, Chalani shall not be liable for any accident or injury occasioned to the mare or her foal at foot, while at stud, nor will the mare owner be held responsible for any accident or injury occasioned to the stallion. Insurance of mares is recommended.

This contract expressly excludes any prior representations and understandings.

9. Service Certificate: All progeny of ASH Stallions may be registered with the Australian Stock Horse Society upon payment of ASH membership fee, foal registration fee, and presentation of the official Stallion Service Certificate (\$15 available at cost from Chalani).
